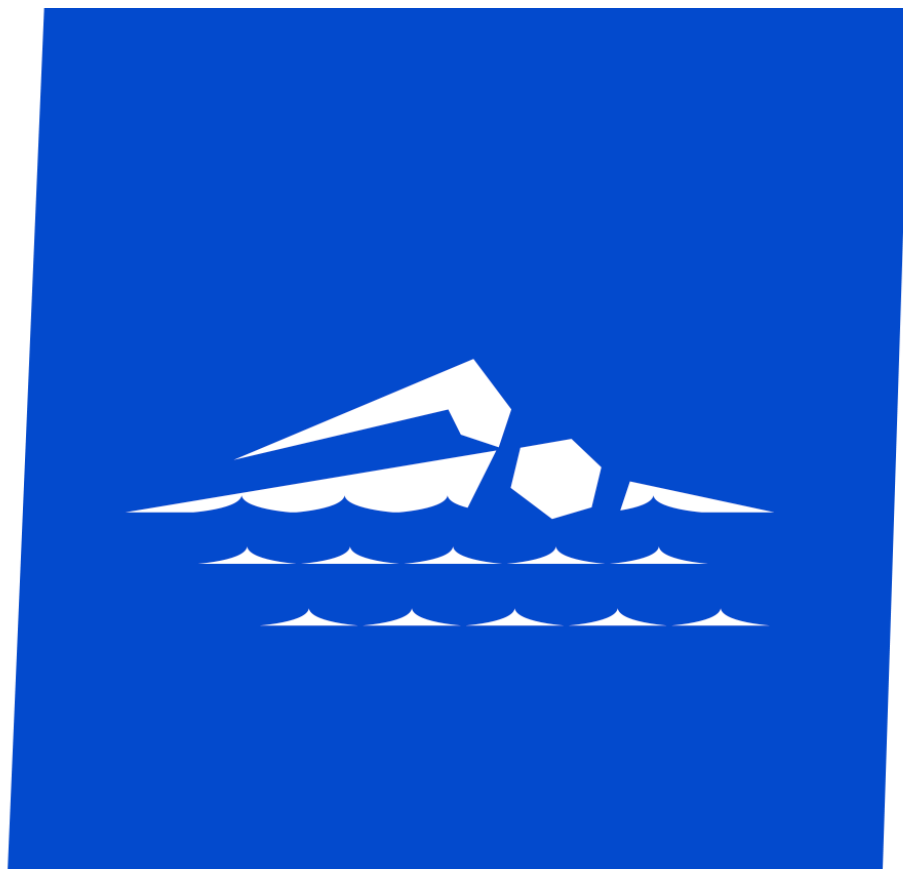

### 1.1. ATHLETES ELEGIBILITY

To participate in the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023, the athlete must follow the regulations of the Games, the rules of the Central American and Caribbean Swimming Confederation (CCCAN) and the rules of the International Swimming Federation (FINA); the athlete must also be registered by their National Olympic Committee (NOC) according to the regulations of Centro Caribe Sports (CCS).

### 1.2. MINIMUM PARTICIPATION

For an event or competition to be considered official, five (5) athletes and an equal number of National Olympic Committees must participate.

If one or more representations after the Technical Meeting are unable to participate for reasons of force majeure, corroborated and verified by (CCS), which is the only one authorized to authorize the event to be held.



The combination of athletes from different countries will not be allowed for the modalities and events that will be convened in the Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023.

### 1.3. NATIONALITY

Athletes participating in the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023, must have the nationality of the country (NOC) that registered them. The nationality of the competitor is determined according to the Regulations of the (CCS).

### 1.4. MINIMUM AGE OF COMPETITORS

Competitors must be fourteen (14) years old, to be completed in the year in which the competition is held.

### 1.5. CLASSIFICATION SYSTEM

- a) All member countries of Centro Caribe Sports and the CCCAN may participate, in addition to Venezuela and Colombia, in their capacity as invited countries to the area events and if recognized by the CCCAN. Associate members recognized by Centro Caribe Sports may also participate, if they have obtained their classification after having participated in the Qualifying system established by CCCAN.
- b) The qualification for the Games will be obtained at the CCCAN 2022 Championship held in Barbados and the second qualifying event to be held in El Salvador on December 4, 2022. The places will be awarded to the National Olympic Committees (NOCs) and not to the athletes.
- c) Each National Federation may be represented by a maximum of two (2) competitors in each gender in these qualifying events.
- d) Ranking Priorities, first (1st) Priority: Two (2) places will be awarded per gender for the Host Country, El Salvador.
- e) Vacancies occurring due to illness, retirement, incapacity due to anti-doping test sanctions, or any other anomaly, will be substituted respecting the ranking of the places obtained in the qualifying events:
  1. CCCAN 2022 Championship in Barbados, ten (10) places in each gender.
  2. Qualifying Event to be held in El Salvador next December, eight (8) places, in this order: If the places assigned are not filled, the athletes in Barbados who are not yet in the list of classified participants will be

incorporated, according to the order of arrival and if they have reached the finish line before the Competition Time Limit. By FINA Rules, these athletes are not consignees of place, nor points in the competition in which they would have participated.

## 1.6. OPEN WATER SWIMMING

Each Federation participating in the 2022 CCCAN Championship may choose to qualify its two athletes, if they placed in the top ten (10) swimmers in each gender at the CCCAN Championship held in Barbados or in the top eight (8) swimmers of the qualifier to be held in El Salvador.

In the qualifier to be held in El Salvador, those athletes whose NOCs have not yet completed two (2) athletes in each gender and the athlete who arrives at the finish line with the right to qualify, has not done so previously, will have the right to qualify. The same athlete may not qualify two places for his NOC. The athlete may compete on two events (Barbados and El Salvador), but only in one of them will the athlete be allowed to obtain a place for the NOC.

The NOC representatives who have completed the maximum quota of 2 athletes, will give up their position to the next swimmers in the arrival order.

### 2.1 ELEGIBILITY

To participate in the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023, the athlete must follow the Regulations of the Games, the rules of the Central American and Caribbean Swimming Confederation (CCCAN) and the rules of the International Swimming Federation (FINA); the athlete must also be registered by the National Olympic Committee (NOC) according to the regulations of Centro Caribe Sports (CCS).

## 2.2 MINIMUM PARTICIPATION

For an event or competition to be considered official, five (5) athletes and an equal number of National Olympic Committees must participate.

If one or more representations after the Technical Meeting are unable to participate for reasons of force majeure, corroborated and verified by (CCS), which is the only one authorized to authorize the event to be held.

## 2.3 NATIONALITY

Athletes participating in the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023, must have the nationality of the country (NOC) that registered them. The nationality of the competitor is determined according to the Regulations of Centro Caribe Sports (CCS).

## 2.4 MINIMUM AGE OF COMPETITORS

The required minimum age will be fourteen (14) years old by 2023.

## 2.5 CLASSIFICATION SYSTEM

- a. As host country, El Salvador will automatically qualify one (1) athlete per individual event and one team per synchronized diving event, for the San Salvador 2023 Diving competition.
- b. Each National Olympic Committee (NOC) may register up to a maximum of eight (8) divers, four (4) women and four (4) men, if they are registering teams in synchronized diving. Each NOC may register a maximum of six (6) divers, three (3) women and three (3) men, if they are not registering teams in synchronized diving.
- c. No later than TBC, each NOC shall submit to the Central American and Caribbean Swimming Confederation (CCCAN) and to the Organizing Committee of the Games a list of the names of the proposed divers to be registered for the Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador

2023. If the number of proposed divers exceeds the quota of fifty (50), the CCCAN in conjunction with the Organizing Committee and Centro Caribe Sports (CCS) will determine the divers qualified to San Salvador 2023 according to the order they finished in the qualifying event, and will communicate this to the NOCs and the Organizing Committee, no later than TBC, in order that the Nominal and Numerical registration can be completed by the established dates by Centro Caribe Sports.

- d. The qualifying competition will be held at the CCCAN 2023 Event at a place and date TBC

### 3.1 ELIGIBILITY

To participate in the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023, the athlete must follow the regulations of the games, the rules of the Central American and Caribbean Swimming Confederation (CCCAN) and the rules of the International Swimming Federation (FINA); the athlete must also be registered by the National Olympic Committee (NOC) according to the regulations of Centro Caribe Sports (CCS).

### 3.2 MINIMUM PARTICIPATION

For an event or competition to be considered official, five (5) athletes and an equal number of National Olympic Committees must participate.

If one or more representations after the Technical Meeting are unable to participate for reasons of force majeure, corroborated and verified by (CCS), which is the only one authorized to authorize the event to be held.

The combination of athletes from different countries will not be allowed for the modalities and events that will be convened in the Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023.

### 3.3 NATIONALITY

Athletes participating in the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023, must have the nationality of the country (NOC) that registered them. The nationality of the competitor is determined according to the Regulations of the (CCS).

### 3.4 AGE OF COMPETITORS

Athletes must be at least 15 years old by December 31, 2023 (born in 2008).

### 3.5 CLASSIFICATION SYSTEM

El Salvador as host country, is automatically qualified for all Swimming events at the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023, with a maximum of twenty (20) athletes, two (2) participants for each individual event and one team in each relay event.

- a) Each country has the automatic participation of two (2) athletes, one (1) woman and one (1) man.
- b) In each individual event, each NOC may register a maximum of two (2) athletes.
- c) In each relay event, each NOC may register a maximum of one (1) team.
- d) Registrations will not be allowed without time ("NT")
- e) Classification process.

The Organizing Committee of the Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023 (COSSAN 2023), the Central American and Caribbean Swimming Confederation (CCCAN) and the International Technical Delegate, will send the official forms for the long list and for the nominal registration on March 30, 2023. They will also be on the Games website. In addition, they will send the competition file in the Team Manager program.

1. The NOCs, including the host country, will have until May 3, 2023, to send CCCAN and the International Technical Delegate, by email the nominal (final) registrations in the Team Manager (TM) program file with the evidence of where the times were made (Proof of Time). The Proof of Times report should be sent in PDF format to the following email: [apinedapanam2023@gmail.com](mailto:apinedapanam2023@gmail.com) addressed to Andrea Pineda, Member of the PAQ Technical Committee.
2. CCCAN and the International Technical Delegate, together with COSSAN 2023 and the Technical Commission of the Caribe Sport Center will carry out the evaluation of the final registrations. The following determinations will be made from this evaluation.

- 2.1 if the total number of athletes in the nominal registrations sent by the NOCs is not greater than 200, all registered swimmers qualify to compete in San Salvador 2023.
- 2.2 If the total number of athletes at the nominal registrations sent by the NOCs is greater than 200, COSSAN 2023, CCCAN and the International Technical Delegate, will use the fine points table to achieve a quota of no more than 200 athletes and that they comply with the concept of "universality" where a NOC will have the right to have at least one female and one male swimmer.
- 2.3 COSSAN 2023/ CCCAN and the International Technical Delegate, will notify each CON of the name of the swimmers who qualified for the games no later than May 15, 2023.
- 2.4.4 NOCs will have until May 30, 2023, to send nominal registrations to COSSAN 2023, CCCAN and the International Technical Delegate.

### 3.6 REGISTRATION TIMES

Registration times must be achieved between January 1, 2022, and April 30, 2023.

### 3.7 QUALIFYING COMPETITIONS

1. An arbitrator or exit judge from FINA's #21y List #22 must officiate the events so that registration times can be considered.
2. The results of the competitions must be sent by each FN to CCCAN and the International Technical Delegate for evaluation, including the name of the referee or the starting judge who officiated at the event. The copy of the results must be sent in Meet Manager format or in PDF format to [apinedapanam2023@gmail.com](mailto:apinedapanam2023@gmail.com), addressed to Andrea Pineda. All FINA qualifying events will be considered qualifiers for a registration time.

### 4.1 ELEGIBILITY

To participate in the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023, the athlete must follow the regulations of the Games, the rules of the Central American and Caribbean Swimming Confederation (CCCAN) and the rules of the International Swimming Federation (FINA); the athlete must also be registered by the National Olympic Committee (NOC) according to the regulations of Centro Caribe Sports (CCS).

Athletes must be eligible according to FINA GR 1 and GR 2 rules.

### 4.2 MINIMUM PARTICIPATION

For an event or competence to be considered official, five (5) athletes and an equal number of National Olympic Committees must participate.

If one or more representations after the Technical Meeting are unable to participate for reasons of force majeure, corroborated and verified by (CCS), which is the only one authorized to authorize the event to be held.

The combination of athletes from different countries will not be allowed for the modalities and events that will be convened in the Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023.

#### 4.3 NATIONALITY

Athletes participating in the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023, must have the nationality of the country (NOC) that registered them. The nationality of the competitor is determined according to the Regulations of the (CCS).

#### 4.4 MINIMUM AGE OF COMPETITORS

Athletes must be at least 14 years old by December 31, 2023 (born in 2009).

#### 4.5 CLASSIFICATION SYSTEM

##### MAXIMUM NUMBER OF COMPETITORS

According to the participation quota established by Centro Caribe Sport, the Artistic Swimming competition will have a maximum of sixty (60) men and women athletes.

##### **Specifications:**

- a) Each CON may register a maximum of nine (9) women athletes if participating in Acrobatic Routine, Team, Duet, Solo (Technical and Free).
- b) Each NOC may participate with a maximum of ten (10) athletes (9 women and 1 man) if participating in Acrobatic Routine, Team, Duet, Mixed Duet and Solo (Technical and Free).
- c) Each country may participate with a maximum of four (4) athletes if participating in Female Duet, Mixed Duet and Solo (3 women and 1 men).
- d) No country may participate only in Solo, Mixed Duet and/or Acrobatic Routine.
- e) In all cases, they must follow the classification criteria stipulated by the CCCAN for Artistic Swimming for the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023.
- f) Only countries participating in the team event may register one (1) replacement in the technical duet and free duet events as well as in the team events.

- a) As host country, El Salvador has qualified a full team (8) female athletes, and one male athlete with one participation in each event.
- b) The qualifying event will be the CCCAN Artistic Swimming Championships 2022 held in Panama from October 16 to 23, 2022, applying the following criteria:
- 1. Teams and Acrobatic Routine:** The first four (4) countries of the Team event will qualify (total of the average of the Technical and Free Routines, according to FINA Regulations).
  - 2. Duets:** The three best placed countries in the Duets event that have not qualified in the Teams event will qualify (total of the average of the Technical and Free Routines, according to FINA Regulations).
  - 3. Mixed Duets:** The four best placed mixed duets will qualify (total of the average of the Technical and Free Routines, according to FINA Regulations). AS 20.2.3.
- c) National Federations must confirm their participation in writing to the CCCAN by November 15, 2022. In case of an open vacancy due to resignation or disqualification due to injury, doping, sanctions, etc., the places will be filled for the next country with a Team, in which case the

same must be presented in Solo, Duet, Team and Acrobatic Routine. If there is no country with the possibility of presenting a team, the vacant places shall be filled by as many countries with duets (2 athletes), being these duets female and/or mixed as necessary, until the maximum quota of 60 athletes is reached.

The result of the eventual reallocations will be notified by the CCCAN to the NFs and the Organizing Committee no later than December 15, 2022, so the NOCs will be able to follow the Centro Caribe Sport Regulations regarding the numerical and nominal inscription.

### 5.3 NATIONALITY

Men: Eight (8) teams will qualify to the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023, as follows:

- a) El Salvador qualifies automatically for hosting the event.
- b) The remaining seven (7) teams will be those placed from 1st to 7th place excluding Colombia at the CCCAN 2022 Championship to be held in Barbados on a date to be determined.

Should any team give up the place obtained, the CCCAN reserves the exclusive right to analyze the case to determine the team that will replace it in agreement with Centro Caribe Sports (CCS).

The combination of athletes from different countries will not be allowed for the modalities and events that will be convened in the Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023.

### 6.3 NATIONALITY

Athletes participating in the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023, must have the nationality of the country (NOC) that registered them. The nationality of the competitor is determined according to the Regulations of the (CCS).

### 6.4 MINIMUM AGE OF COMPETITORS

The category for the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023 is open.

### 6.5 CLASSIFICATION SYSTEM

## 7.1 ELIGIBILITY

To participate in the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023, the athlete must follow the regulations of the Games, the rules of the North, Central American and Caribbean Association of Athletics (NACAC) and the rules of World Athletics (WA); the athlete must also be registered by the National Olympic Committee (NOC) according to the regulations of Centro Caribe Sports (CCS).

## 7.2 MINIMUM PARTICIPATION

For an event or competition to be considered official, five (5) athletes or pairs and an equal number of National Olympic Committees must participate.

In case one or more representations after the Technical Meeting are not able to participate for reasons of force majeure, corroborated and proven by Centro Caribe Sports (CCS) who is the only one authorized to allow the realization of the event. Centro Caribe Sports will decide.

The combination of athletes from different countries will not be allowed for the modalities and events that are announced in the Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023.

## 7.3 NATIONALITY

Athletes participating in the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023, must have the nationality of the country (NOC) that registered them. The nationality of the competitor is determined according to the Centro Caribe Sports (CCS) Regulations.

## 7.4 MINIMUM AGE OF COMPETITORS

- Athletes aged 18 or 19 on December 31, 2023 (born in 2004 or 2005), may not compete in the Half Marathon and 35 km Race Walk events.

- Athletes aged 16 or 17 years old on December 31, 2023 (born in 2006 or 2007) may not compete in the Throws, Combined Trials, 10,000 meters, Half Marathon and the 20Km and 35Km Race Walk events.
- Any athlete under 16 years old on December 31, 2023 (born in 2008 or later) is not allowed to register.

## 7.5 CLASSIFICATION SYSTEM

### Individual events

Each National Olympic Committee (NOC) may participate with a maximum of two qualified athletes in each individual event.

- a. For the maximum quota of competitors per individual event, the first positions will be considered according to the Central American and Caribbean ranking, which must be completed on the established dates until the maximum quota for each event is reached.
- b. The World Athletics ranking by event shall be used as a reference.

### Relay events

For the 4 x 100m and 4 x 400m relays, men and women, and the mixed 4 x 400m relay, the national teams will be qualified according to the following:

- a. The 4 (four) members of each relay team (4x100m, 4x400m and 4x400m mixed), must be qualified and registered in any individual event.
- b. Each NOC may register up to a maximum of 2 (two) competitors participating only in each 4X100 and 4X400 relay race. In the case of the 4x400m mixed relay, 1 man and 1 woman must register.

### Universality Places

The principles of universality, parity and equity shall be observed. All NOCs have the right to register at least one (1) man and one (1) woman in any event, considering the following aspects:

- a. The NOCs must propose to Centro Caribe Sports, the athlete from their country, men and/or women, who occupies the best position in the world ranking

- according to the World Athletics Scoring Tables of Athletics - Outdoor at the closing date of the applications. Events longer than 1,500 meters as well as Combined Events are not eligible for universality places.
- b. The International Technical Delegates will decide whether or not to accept the registration and will have the authority to establish which athlete and in which event may participate in the games based on the criterion of universality of classification.

### Host Country Places

El Salvador will automatically qualify with one (1) athlete for all Athletics events where they do not have qualified athletes, for being the host country of the Central American and Caribbean Games, San Salvador 2023. The following aspects must be considered:

- a. In case of requiring 2 places in an event, both athletes must be the best classified athletes of El Salvador in the World Athletics ranking.
- b. El Salvador will determine the classification system of its athletes for this competition.

The following table shows the maximum quota per event in the Central American and Caribbean Games, considering the following variables:

- a. Places granted by universality
- b. Seats granted to the host country
- c. Ranking by World Athletics events

### Timing for classification

The World Athletics ranking system will be used as a reference for the classification system. The dates established are as follows:

- a. For the Half Marathon, Race Walking, Combined Trials and 10,000 meters, they will be able to run them from January 1, 2022, to May 7, 2023.
- b. For the rest of the events, the dates established are from May 1, 2022, to May 7, 2023.

### Validity of results

- a. Results shall be achieved during competitions organized or sanctioned by World Athletics, its area associations (NACAC/South American Athletics) or member federations and conducted according to the rules of World Athletics and for which (starting January 1, 2023) an application must be submitted in advance (see below).
- b. The results obtained in school or university competitions must be certified by the member federation of the country in which the competition was organized, and must comply with the authorizations of the respective World Athletics and Area Association.
- c. Results achieved in mixed competitions in track events will not be accepted. Exceptionally, according to Article 9 of the World Athletics Regulations, results achieved in the 5,000m and 10,000m events may be accepted in circumstances where there have not been enough athletes of one or both genders competing to justify separate races and there has been no passing or assistance by an athlete of one gender to an athlete of the other gender. Where applicable, member federations must submit a specific request to their respective area association, providing the required documentation.
- d. Results obtained downwind will not be accepted.
- e. Manually timed results will not be accepted in the events of 100m, 200m, 400m, 800m, 1,500m, 110m/100m hurdles, 400m hurdles, 4 x 100m and 4 x 400m relays and 4 x 400m mixed relay.
- f. The results of all field events held on indoor tracks, as well as races of 200m or more, will be accepted.
- g. Results from events of 200m or more obtained on oversized indoor tracks (over 200m) will not be accepted.

From January 1, 2023, in the case of National Allowed Competitions, in addition to compliance with the above, all results must be achieved in a competition for which an application has been submitted to World Athletics in advance. The list of such competitions will be published on the Global Calendar pages of the World Athletics website.

## Marching

Results obtained in international walking competitions as defined in World Athletics Rule 1.1 (a), (b), (c), (d), I, (f), (g) or (j) shall be valid for ranking purposes, provided that the following conditions (where applicable) are respected:

- a. The route shall contain the certificate of a WA /AIMS approved Grade A or B international road race measurer.
- b. The measurement certificate shall have been authorized no more than five years prior to the date of the competition.
- c. There shall be a minimum of three international or area marching judges acting as judges.
- d. The results of the track walking event (20,000m and 35,000m) will be accepted.

## Half Marathon

Only Half Marathon results that fulfill the following criteria will be considered valid in terms of minimum participation marks:

- a. The course shall contain the certificate of a WA /AIMS approved, Grade A or B international road race measurer.
- b. The measurer's certificate shall have been authorized no more than five years prior to the date of the race.

To participate in the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023, the athlete must follow the regulations of the Games, the rules of the Badminton World Federation (BWF) and the Central American and Caribbean Badminton Confederation (CONCECABA); the athlete must also be registered by the National Olympic Committee (NOC) according to the regulations of Centro Caribe Sports (CCS).

d) The (NOC) must confirm the quotas, in writing to Centro Caribe Sports (CCS) and (CONCECABA) before January 17, 2023. Countries that do not receive maximum quotas (3 quotas or less) reflecting the acceptance document of the assigned quotas the interest in receiving extra quotas in case of having them. In case of reallocation of quotas, countries that received three (3) quotas for men and three (3) quotas for women and, also probably (NOCs) that received two (2) quotas for men and two (2) quotas for women, will be authorized to receive up to four (4) quotas for men and four (4) quotas for women, respecting strictly the ranking countries order. This decision will be taken by (CONCECABA) and informed to the Organizing Committee no later than January 20, 2023, so that the favored (NOC's) have the possibility of complying with the dates established by Centro Caribe Sports (CCS) to make the numerical and nominal registration .

## Athlete Eligibility

- All players registered for this competition must have acquired the legal nationality of that country and have complied with the registration conditions provided in FIBA's internal regulations and be duly approved in the FIBA MAP.
  - Eligibility regulation will be carried out according to the FIBA Internal Regulations identified in Books 2 and 3. With this objective in mind, FIBA has enabled access to the Administration Platform (known as FIBA MAP) to all National Federations.

## Eligibility – Trainers

- Coaches submitted in preliminary registration (sent via MAP) must have a FIBA Coaching License to be eligible.

- A minimum of two (2) and a maximum of three (3) coaches (one of them must be the head coach) valid, approved, and included in the Preliminary Delegation List.

The National Federations will receive in advance from FIBA the list of players approved for the competition. Participating teams must print this list and make sure that the players and coaches have a valid passport and present it to the International Technical Delegate for verification at the technical meeting.

All countries, through their National Olympic Committee, must carry out their registration process through the Organizing Committee's information system, under instructions that will be sent to each National Olympic Committee.

It is necessary to send your applications of intention to participate in sports in the official formats defined by the Organizing Committee. You have to indicate in them the sports in which you have the intention to participate in the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games, San Salvador 2022.

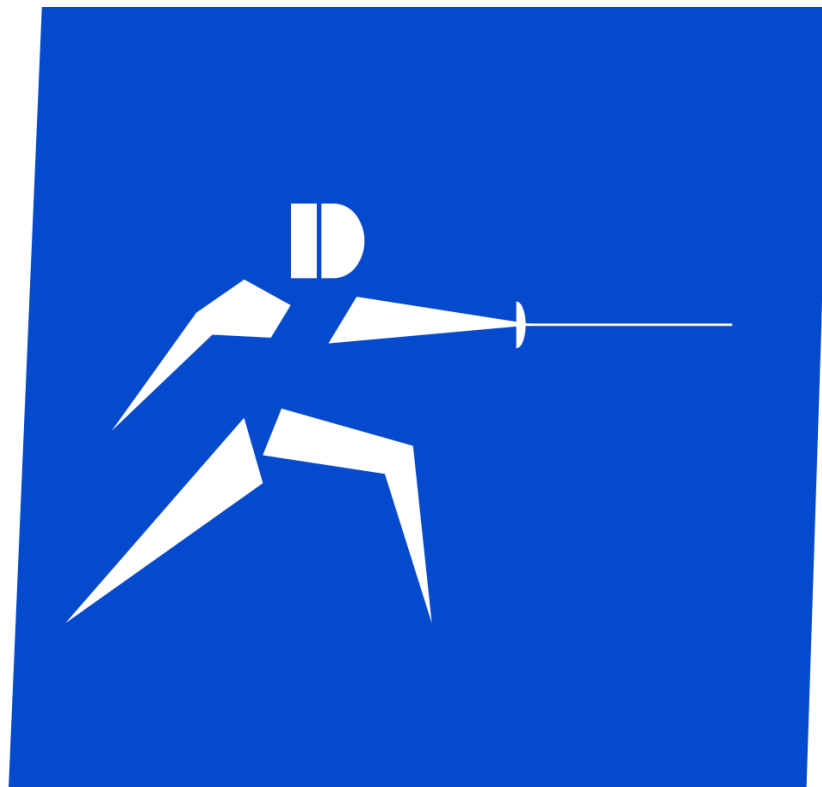

### 19.5 QUOTAS AND SYSTEM FOR EACH CENTRAL AMERICAN REGION

10 male and 8 female athletes (two per modality or event) must qualify for the Central American Qualifying Championship 2022 in Guatemala, each athlete must be from a different country in their modality and there will be two for each modality and gender, and each athlete member of their delegation can make Crossover allowed according to IFBB regulations.

The classified athletes will be the first, second and third place in each announced modality with three quotas for Central America and first and second place in the announced modality with two quotas within the framework of this Championship, if athletes from the same country are repeated, only the best score will be the classified athlete and the second best score of the athlete from a different country and third score in the case of three quotas, regardless of the corresponding place in said championship.

## 19.6 CARIBBEAN

16 men and 12 women athletes must qualify for the Central American and Caribbean Championship in Barbados. Each athlete must be from a different country in his or her category and there will be five athletes for each category and gender, for a total of 28 athletes.

The qualified athletes will be from first to fourth place in each modality in the Central American and Caribbean Championship in Barbados in Bikini, Body fitness, Games Classic 1.71 and Games Classic +1. 71, from first to fourth in Male Fitness, Female Fitness and Bodybuilding up to 70 kg, if any athlete from the same country is repeated in any modality and gender, only the best score will be classified and the repeated quota for the same country, will go to the athlete with the best after the repeated athlete from a different country after the fourth place according to the category in which the athlete competes.

If in a specific case, the Caribbean countries that have qualified athletes do not obtain recognition and support from their NOC, this quota will be awarded to the country that has recognition and support, but also does not have a qualified athlete in that modality and gender, regardless of the region, which means that in this case Central America has the right to request this quota.

## 19.7 SUBSTITUTE ATHLETES

The substitute athletes will be those who obtain a place in the Central American and Caribbean Championship in addition to the best qualified athlete selected as a starter, being this athlete from the same country, since only one athlete will be able to participate in the Central American and Caribbean Games.

This athlete may participate, replacing the principal athlete and represent the country if the principal athlete is disqualified due to major force (accident, injury, etc.), except for a doping case.

If the athlete is positive in the anti-doping tests, the country and the National Federation will lose the participation and replacement quota, being totally disqualified from participating in the Central American and Caribbean Games.

If a regular athlete is disqualified for the aforementioned reasons, the National Federation may decide to choose a substitute athlete, making known through an internal selective process the results of this athlete proposed as a replacement, in case the proposed athlete has not participated or obtained qualification in the Central

American and Caribbean Championship in Barbados, and said athlete will follow the regulations established and mentioned above.

### 19.8 DESIGNATION OF DIRECT QUOTAS (WILD CARD)

In the case of places being available for different reasons, the International Federation of Bodybuilding and Fitness (IFBB) will consider these places with Wild Card status and will be the same who designate or award these quotas to countries or National Federations who through an internal selective process designate the athlete representing the same and this athlete must meet all the requirements mentioned above along with their national federation, this condition includes all regions and countries included in the jurisdiction of the Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023.

- a. In case a qualified team confirms its participation with only 1 or 2 gymnasts, the place as a full team will be assigned to the next NOC according to the team results in the Qualifying competition of the Pan American Adult Championships.
- b. In case of a lower number of teams than those established in the classification system, the unused places will be distributed according to the results of the overall individual classification of the Pan American Adult Championship.

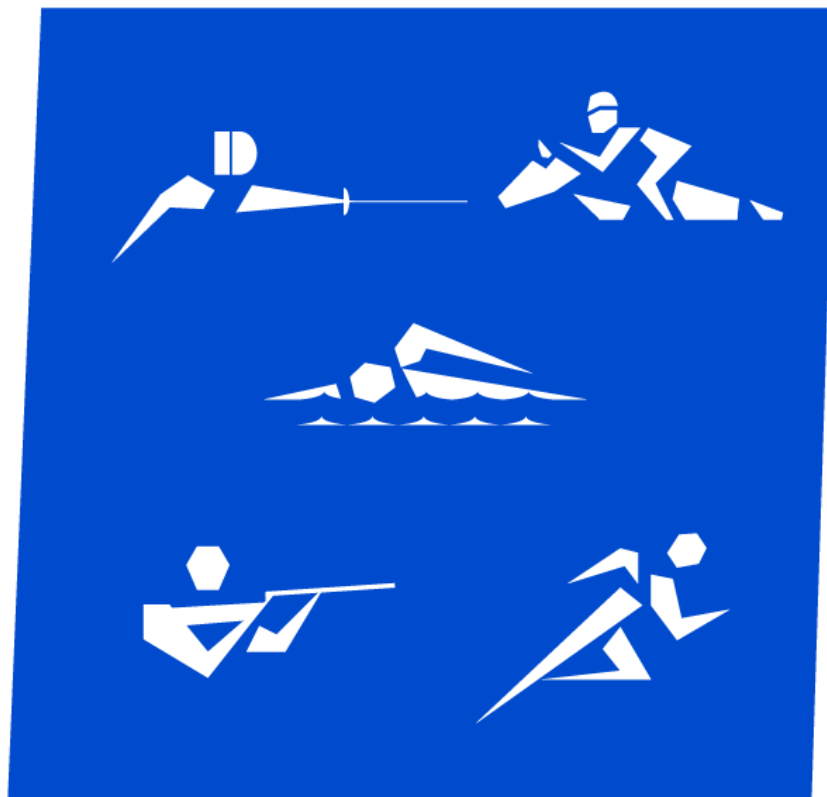

Kyorugui competitors must be at least seventeen (17) years old in the year of competition (born in 2006 or earlier).

Poomsae competitors must be at least 16 years old (born in 2007 or earlier).

### 36.5 MAXIMUM NUMBER OF COMPETITORS

According to the quota established by Centro Caribe Sport (CCS) the Taekwondo competitions will have a total of one hundred and eighty (180) athletes, ninety (90) men and ninety (90) women.

Each National Olympic Committee (NOC), including the host country, may register a maximum of sixteen (16) athletes in total, eight (8) women and eight (8) men, as long as they have qualified according to the criteria of the Pan American Taekwondo Union (PATU) for the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023 (Sub Host: Dominican Republic).

### 36.6 CLASSIFICATION SYSTEM

1. Each country may present one (1) Kyorugui athlete for each weight division in the official qualification tournament. For Poomsae, each country may present up to two (2) athletes in Poomsae. Each athlete may participate in a maximum of 2 events of the National Olympic Committee's (NOC) choice. Each country may present one team per category of (3) three athletes in the Team Kyorugui modality.
2. Each country can qualify in Kyorugui a maximum of 4 men and 4 women athletes for the qualification tournament. For Poomsae, each country may qualify a maximum of 2 events, for Poomsae competitions in both styles. Pairs events may be formed with any of the individual participants. Each country may participate with up to one (1) team per category in Team Kyorugui; 3 men and 3 women.
3. El Salvador (ESA) as host country classifies its athletes in all divisions and events automatically, unless it decides not to participate in some of them, for which it must inform the Pan American Taekwondo Union (PATU) prior to the qualifying tournament.
4. The categories or places in which (ESA) does not decide to participate will be awarded directly to the Dominican Republic (DOM) as Sub Venue for the Taekwondo competitions of the Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023.
5. The places in which (ESA) or (DOM) are registered will be included in the qualifying event, so that any country can apply for them.
6. The qualification tournament will only award the places to the country, meaning that the qualification is not nominal. Each country must have its own team selection process based on the quotas achieved in the qualification tournament.

7. If a qualifying place is not represented by the stated registration deadline, whether caused by athlete injury, withdrawal or for some unexpected reason, the Pan American Taekwondo Union (PATU) will replace that weight category as a wildcard. A wildcard will be assigned to a country that participated in the qualifying tournament but did not qualify any athlete.
8. If there are many eligible countries against a limited number of wild cards, the Pan American Taekwondo Union (PATU) will designate the wild cards based on each country's history of participation in the last official Pan American Taekwondo Union (PATU) events).
9. In the event that it is not feasible due to accommodation difficulties to organize an official ranking tournament, the Pan American Taekwondo Union (PATU) will select the best qualified athletes in each weight category in the (WT) World Ranking at the time of selection according to the competition record in the events.

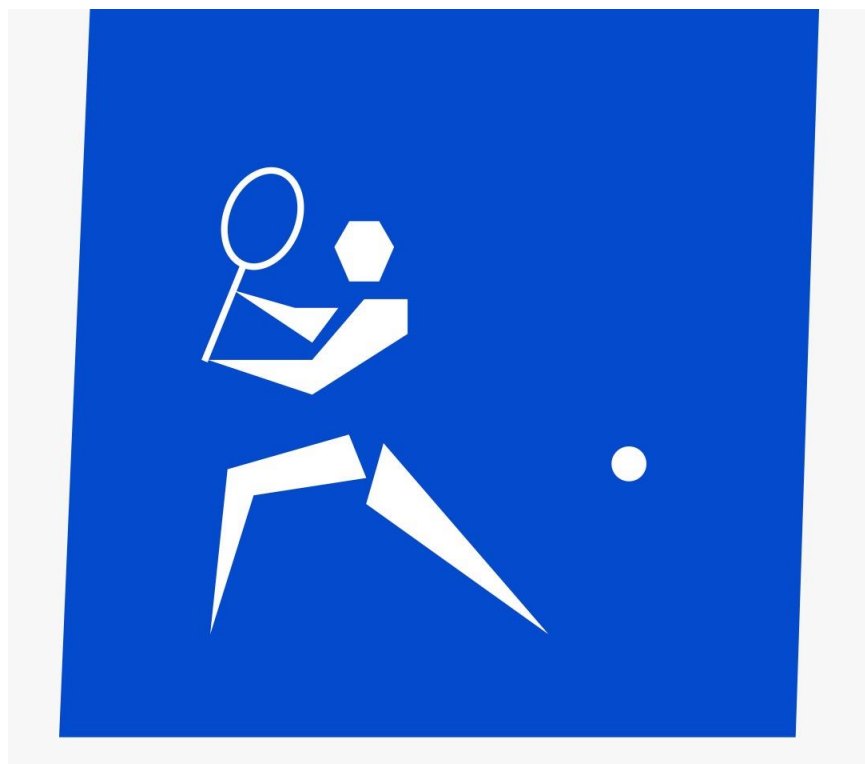
### 36.6.1 CONFIRMATION OF PLACES

The Pan American Taekwondo Union will confirm to Centro Caribe Sports (CCS) and the National Olympic Committees (NOC) that have qualified no later than TBC, 2023.

The (NOCs) will confirm to Centro Caribe Sports (CCS) and the Pan American Taekwondo Union (PATU) the places they will use, no later than TBC, 2023.

### 36.6.2 REASSIGNMENT OF UNUSED POSITIONS

If necessary, the Pan American Taekwondo Union (PATU) will reassign the unused places to the next highest placed NOC that has not yet qualified, no later than the 2023 TBC. The NOCs that have received reassigned places must confirm their participation no later than TBC 2023.

## 37.1 ELIGIBILITY

To participate in the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023, the athlete must follow the regulations of the Games, the rules of the International Tennis Federation (ITF); they must also be registered by the National Olympic Committee (NOC) according to the regulations of Centro Caribe Sports (CCS).

## 37.2 MINIMUM PARTICIPATION

For an event or test to be considered official, five (5) athletes and an equal number of National Olympic Committees must participate.

If one or more representations after the Technical Meeting are unable to participate for reasons of force majeure, corroborated and verified by (CCS), which is the only one authorized to authorize the event to be held.

The combination of athletes from different countries will not be allowed for the modalities and events that will be convened in the Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023.

### **37.3** NATIONALITY

Athletes participating in the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023, must have the nationality of the country (NOC) that registered them. The nationality of the competitor is determined according to the Regulations of Centro Caribe Sports (CCS).

### **37.4** MINIMUM AGE OF COMPETITORS

Competitors must be at least 14 (fourteen) years old on the first day of the competition.

### **37.5** MAXIMUM NUMBER OF COMPETITORS

According to the quota established by Centro Caribe Sports, the Tennis competition will have a maximum of eighty-eight (88) athletes, combining men and women.

### **37.6** SPECIFICATIONS

- a) Each country may participate in the Games with a maximum of four (4) men and four (4) women.
- b) In the Individual events, each country may participate with a maximum of two (2) men and two (2) women players.
- c) In the Doubles events, each country may participate with a maximum of one (1) pair per event.
- d) In the Nations Cup events each country may participate with four (4) men and four (4) women respectively.
- e) Each player may participate in a maximum of two (2) events plus the Nations Cup.

## 37.7 CLASSIFICATION SYSTEM

- a) Direct acceptances will be selected in order of merit based on:
  1. the ATP and WTA individual rankings as of Monday, May 15, 2023.
  2. the WTN singles of those registered as of Monday, May 15, 2023.
- a) As host country, El Salvador is automatically qualified in all events with full teams.
- b) The composition of the keys will be as follows:
  1. In Men's Singles, 42 direct registrations and 6 wild cards will be allowed. Total of 48.
  2. In Women's Singles, 28 direct registrations and 4 wild cards will be allowed. Total of 32
  3. In Men's Doubles, 22 direct teams and 2 wild cards may participate.
  4. In Women's Doubles, 14 direct teams and 2 wild cards may participate.
  5. In Mixed Doubles, 14 direct teams and 2 wild cards may participate.
  6. A maximum of 8 teams per gender will participate in the Women's and Men's Nations Cup, which will qualify for the event based on their results in singles and doubles.

### MEN'S AND WOMEN'S EVENTS.

The points of the players of each country are added up, by gender for each event, where winning 1st place awards 5 points, 2nd place awards 4 points, 3rd place awards 3 points, 4th place awards 2 points and losing in the quarterfinals awards 1 point, for the singles, doubles, and mixed doubles events. The teams with the first 8 places in points qualify. In case of a tie in points for any position, it will be resolved as follows:

- Team with highest combined singles and doubles ATP/WTA ranking (as of the starting week of the tennis event) of all its players - if tie persists,
- Team with highest combined singles WTN (from the start week of the event) of all its players - if tie persists,
- Top-ranked Davis Cup/Billie Jean King Cup team in the opening week of the tennis event - and if the tie persists,
- Raffle.
- Wild cards will be assigned by the COTECC Board of Directors. Applications must be sent on the official form completed by the National Federation, no later than May 26, 2023, to the DTI, who will prepare the list and submit it to the COTECC Directors for decision.



- Each National Tennis Federation shall send the names of its players to be entered in the Tennis competition to the International Technical Delegate (ITD) at **direcciontecnicacotecc@hotmail.com** no later than **MONDAY MAY 15, 2023**, for the Acceptance List to be prepared. This Acceptance List will be published and sent to the Organizing Committee no later than May 18, 2023 so that the NOCs can officially register the accepted players before the official deadline for nominal registrations.

In case of withdrawals or changes, the substitute players will be selected as follows:

1. If the country that loses a player by withdrawal has another unregistered player with a ranking or WTN level (as of Monday, May 15, 2023) that allows the athlete to be in the main draw of the designated event (singles and/or doubles), can register the athlete until Monday, 2 weeks before the start of the singles draw.
2. After that time, substitutions will only be made using the list of alternates.
3. If the country that loses a player by withdrawal has no substitute with a ranking or WTN level that allows direct acceptance, the next eligible player on the list of alternates will take the available place.
4. The last time to make changes in the nomination of players PER EVENT, if the Organizing Committee has the athlete officially registered, will be 36 hours before the Technical Congress, with the Referee of the Competition. It is the responsibility of the Delegate of each team to contact the Referee.

### 37.8 APPROVAL OF THE CLASSIFICATION SYSTEM

This classification system was reviewed and approved by COTECC and ITF on April 20, 2022.

### 38.1 ELIGIBILITY

To participate in the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023, the athlete must follow the regulations of the Games, the rules of the Latin American Table Tennis Union (ULTM) and the rules of the International Table Tennis Federation (ITTF); they must also be registered by their National Olympic Committee (NOC) according to the provisions of Centro Caribe Sports (CCS) Statutes.

### 38.2 MINIMUM PARTICIPATION

For an event or competition to be considered official, five (5) athletes and an equal number of National Olympic Committees must participate.

If one or more representations after the Technical Meeting are unable to participate for reasons of force majeure, corroborated and verified by (CCS), which is the only one authorized to authorize the event to be held.

The combination of athletes from different countries will not be allowed for the modalities and events that will be convened in the Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023.

### 38.3 NATIONALITY

Athletes participating in the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023, must have the nationality of the country (NOC) that registered them.

The nationality of the competitor is determined according to the Regulations of the (CCS).

### 38.4 MINIMUM AGE OF COMPETITORS

All athletes must be at least 14 years old to participate in the Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023.

### 38.5 CLASSIFICATION SYSTEM

- a) Host country: San Salvador will automatically qualify with a full team of athletes, four (4) men and four (4) women.
- b) ITTF World Ranking: Top three teams from Central America and the Caribbean in men and women at XX of XXXXX of 2023 TBC.
- c) The top 8 in the men's and women's Team event of the Central American and Caribbean Qualifying Tournament to be held at a venue and date to be decided in 2023.
- d) Individual Events: The four best male and female players in the Individual event of the 2023 Central American and Caribbean Qualifying Tournament, which countries have not qualified in the Team event of the Qualifying Tournament. No more than 2 men and 2 women players from the same country may qualify under this criterion.
- e) The National Olympic Committees (NOC) shall confirm in writing to the ULTM the places to be filled no later than the TBC. In case of resignation or vacancies, their substitution will be decided in first place by the results of the Central American and Caribbean Qualifying Tournament and as second rule by the ITTF-ITTF Americas World Ranking; in case of not appearing in said Ranking, the Team or Player Ranking criteria will be requested to the ITTF Competition Department. This decision will be provided by the ULTM to the Organizing Committee San Salvador 2023 and to Centro Caribe Sports (CCS) no later than the TBC of 2023 so the NOCs will be able to comply with the dates stipulated by the CCS for the nominal and numerical inscription.

### 39.5.2 MAXIMUM NUMBER TO REGISTER BY A NOC DURING THE CENTRAL AMERICAN AND CARIBBEAN GAMES

e) CLASSIFICATION PROCEDURE

1. A NOC may only register in the qualifying event a maximum of 3 athletes per modality and gender.
2. For a competition to be considered valid for the awarding of places, it must have the participation of athletes from 5 National Olympic Committees. If for justified reasons and verified by the Central American and Caribbean Shooting Confederation (CTCC), a registered NOC does not arrive at the competition, it will be considered valid with 4 participating NOCs.
3. An athlete may only win one place, which will be for his Federation.
4. Undistributed or returned seats will be released on the following basis:
  - The countries that have participated, did not reach any quota and request it in writing. These will be distributed according to the best percentage placement in correspondence with the number of participants in each modality.

#### 40.7 PLACES BY INVITATION (WILD CARDS)

### 41.1 ELIGIBILITY

To participate in the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023, the athlete must follow the Regulations of the games, the rules of the Central American and Caribbean Triathlon Union (UCECATRI) and the rules of the International Triathlon Federation; they must also be registered by the National Olympic Committee (NOC) according to the regulations of Centro Caribe Sports (CCS).

### 41.2 MINIMUM PARTICIPATION

For an event or competition is considered official, five (5) athletes and an equal number of National Olympic Committees must participate.

If one or more representations after the Technical Meeting are unable to participate for reasons of force majeure, corroborated and verified by (CCS), which is the only one authorized to allow the event to be held.

The combination of athletes from different countries will not be allowed for the modalities and events to be held in the Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023.

### 41.3 NATIONALITY

Athletes participating in the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023, must have the nationality of the country (NOC) that registered them. The nationality of the competitor is determined according to the CCS Regulations.

### 41.4 CLASSIFICATION SYSTEM

The maximum number of places per country will be defined according to the Pan American Ranking as of January 31, 2023, and the results of the Central American and Caribbean Games of previous editions. The maximum number of competitors per country will be up to three (3) female athletes and up to three (3) male athletes in the individual events. For the mixed relay events, the team shall be formed by members of the same country.

### 41.5 PLACES BY INVITATION

In case of not completing the places established in the maximum number of competitors, UCECATRI may assign extra places by Invitation, to the Federations that request it in order of orders received, up to a maximum per country established by the quota assigned by Centro Caribe Sports.

Countries that don't have obtained places according to the criteria "According to the quota established by Centro Caribe Sports, the Triathlon competitions will have a maximum of sixty (60) athletes: thirty (30) women and thirty (30) men" will have priority".

### 42.1 ELIGIBILITY

To participate in the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games, San Salvador 2023, the athlete must follow the regulations of the Games, the rules of the Central American and Caribbean Sailing Confederation (COCECAVE) and the rules of the International Sailing Federation (ISAF); they must also be registered by their National Olympic Committee (NOC) according to the regulations of Centro Caribe Sports (CCS).

### 42.2 MINIMUM PARTICIPATION

For an event or competition to be considered official, five (5) athletes and an equal number of National Olympic Committees must participate.

If one or more representations after the Technical Meeting are unable to participate

for reasons of force majeure, corroborated and verified by (CCS), which is the only one authorized to authorize the event to be held.

The combination of athletes from different countries will not be allowed for the modalities and events that will be convened in the Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023.

### 42.3 NATIONALITY

Athletes participating in the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023, must have the nationality of the country (NOC) that registered them.

The nationality of the competitor is determined according to the Regulations of the (CCS).

### 42.4 MINIMUM AGE OF COMPETITORS

Competitors must be at least fifteen (15) years old in the competition year (born in 2008).

### 42.5 CLASSIFICATION SYSTEM

- a. El Salvador as host country will be automatically qualified with a full team of twelve (12) athletes and the remaining one hundred and four (104) places will be assigned to the other members of COCECAVE.
- b. Each NOC shall have one (1) quota (of its choice) in each of the sailing classes.
- c. NOCs must report their participation in writing to COCECAVE and COSSAN 2023 by January 26, 2023.

The unused places will be redistributed according to COCECAVE's analysis and will be reported to the CONS, COSSAN 2023 and CCS no later than February 11, 2023, so the NOCs will be able to follow the CCS Regulation regarding numerical and nominal registration.

- d. In case any event of a class does not fulfill the minimum of five (5) registered athletes by April 10, 2023, it will be cancelled and will not be substituted by another event, but the remaining places will be assigned to the other events up to the total of one hundred and sixteen (116) athletes.
- e. The maximum number of quotas for each of the ten (10) sailing events is described as follows:

- f. Unclaimed quotas will be reallocated by the Qualifying Committee as follows, as well as quotas that exceed the maximum of 116 competitors (except item e).
- g. If necessary, there will be NOCs that may register up to 2 teams per event.
- h. Priority will be given to an athlete/country for a class in which the athlete has won a gold medal in the previous Games.
- i. Any remaining quotas will be assigned according to the results as of January 31, 2023, or the most recent available:
  - World WS Ranking if applicable.
  - Regional Championships (with a minimum of three (3) countries) that have existed in the three (3) years prior to the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023 with emphasis on the last eighteen (18) months.According to the judgment of the Qualification Committee, based on previous participations and places, as well as extemporaneous cancellations.
- j. Classification Committee:

The classification procedures and regulations shall be the responsibility of the COCECAVE Classification Committee which is composed of two members of the COCECAVE Executive Committee appointed by its President, the Technical Delegate on behalf of WS and the Technical Director of the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023 Regatta.
- k. The Classification Committee may modify the number of athletes in a class.

### 43.1 ELIGIBILITY

Only the National Olympic Committees (NOC) recognized by Centro Caribe Sports (CCS), whose National Volleyball Federations are members of the International Volleyball Federation (FIVB, Fédération Internationale de Volleyball) and the North, Central American & Caribbean Volleyball Confederation (NORCECA, North, Central American & Caribbean Volleyball Confederation), may register athletes in the Volleyball competition of the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023. If they are recognized by NORCECA, associate members recognized by Centro Caribe Sports (CCS) may also participate.

### 43.2 MINIMUM PARTICIPATION

For an event or competition to be considered official, five (5) athletes and an equal number of National Olympic Committees must participate.

In the event that one or more representations after the Technical Meeting are unable to participate for reasons of force majeure, corroborated and proven by (CCS), which is the only one authorized to allow the realization of the event.

The combination of athletes from different countries will not be authorized for the modalities and events to be held in the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023.

### 43.3 NACIONALIDAD

Athletes participating in the XXIV Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023, must have the nationality of the country (NOC) that registered them. The nationality of the competitor is determined according to the Centro Caribe Sports (CCS) Regulations.

The nationality of the competitor is determined according to the CCS, FIVB and NORCECA Regulations.

### 43.4 MINIMUM AGE OF COMPETITORS

All participating athletes must be at least 14 years of age.

### 43.5 CLASSIFICATION SYSTEM

As host country, El Salvador will automatically qualify. The rest of the teams will qualify according to the following criteria:

- a) All member countries of Centro Caribe Sports and NORCECA may participate, in addition to Venezuela and Colombia, as NORCECA, as well as Venezuela and Colombia, in their capacity as Guest countries to the events of the area.
